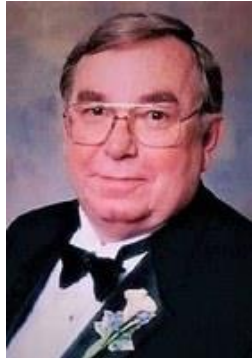


# Dale Martin Jurk
