Soldier Dies In Vietnam

Wayne Teeple Was Former Resident – Army Spec. 4 Wayne W. Teeple, 24, son of Mr. and Mrs. Winston A. Teeple, 19160 Meir Road, Roseville, former Port Huron residents, was killed in action March 3 in Vietnam.

He was born Jan. 2, 1945, in Port Huron. He was a 1963 graduate of Port Huron High School. He was graduated from City Barber College, Detroit, in 1964 and served his apprenticeship in Andy's and Val King's barber shops in Port Huron. He received his barber license in 1966.

When he was inducted into the Army Dec. 5, 1967, he was employed at the Macomb Mall Barber Shop.

He was a member of Westhaven Baptist Church.

He arrived in Vietnam May 5, 1968.

Specialist Teeple is survived by his parents; a sister, Mrs James (Joyce) Hyde; a niece, Jonine Hyde; a nephew, James Hyde; grandmother, Mrs. Margaret Harvey, all of Port Huron and aunts, uncles and cousins of Michigan, California, and Canada.
