### The Blue Water Tour

The one hour tour, which includes a swing by various local points of interest, takes you through the heart of Port Huron and along the river front for a panoramic glimpse of the Blue Water Bridges, the Thomas Edison Statue, and Depot. The starting point for each run is Downtown at 331 Huron Avenue. You can also catch the trolley at Blue Water Area Transit's Quay Street transfer point, where other system buses interconnect, and at other designated stops shown on the Tour Map.

The Blue Water Trolley's season begins on June 11th and runs through September 8th, then runs every Saturday until October 13th.


