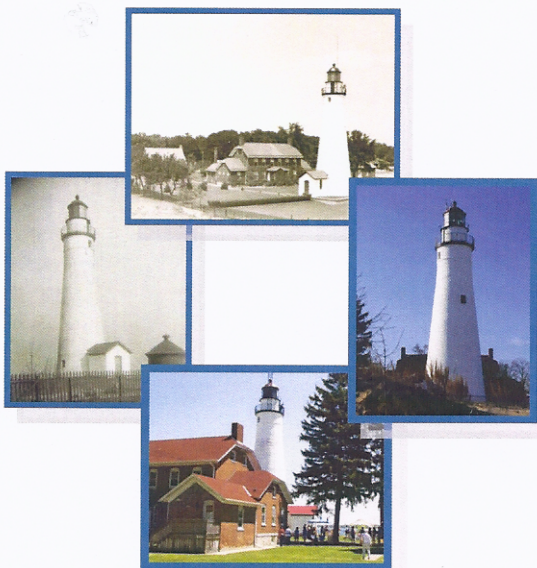

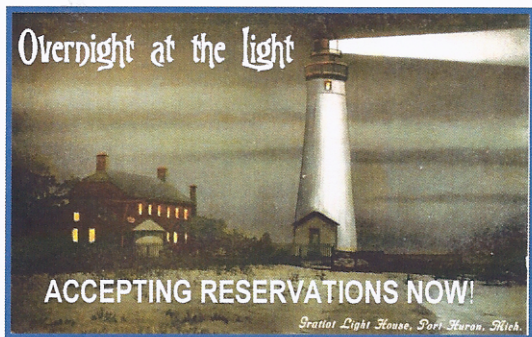
Port Huron Museum
