If you been looking at the web page, then you will have an idea what I am about to say. I recently received catering estimates from Chef Shell's. In a nut shell (no pun intended) she is offering up two menu selections. The menus are as follows:

Traditional BBQ

Homemade creamy coleslaw, TexMex baked beans, Roadkill Roy's BBQ pulled pork, oven roasted chicken, herb roasted potatoes, fresh fruits, deserts, iced tea, lemonade.

Cost: \$16.43 per plate.
